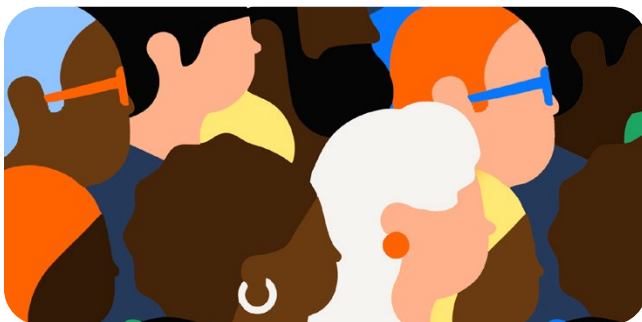
## Investment in the Bluegrass State

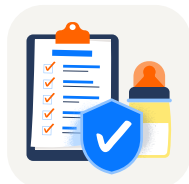
