A community garden project for hands-on learning and community engagement.

Removing illegal dumpsites, engaging the community, and promoting litter prevention and enforcement efforts.

A digital skills and creative tech lab for teens focused on digital literacy, creative tech, and career readiness.

Delivering nutritious, chef-made dinners to food-insecure individuals and families in Luzerne County.

Enhancing a STEM program by acquiring new 3D printers, computers, robotics kits, and furniture to support hands-on learning for local youth.

A mobile astronomy outreach initiative, engaging 3,000 high school students across three campuses in Luzerne and Columbia Counties.

Greater Pittston Land Revitalization Corporation

A community garden project that will maintain 8 garden beds and support free community events.

Green Neighbors Network

A community garden to bring people together, grow food, support pollinators, and continue teaching the next generation how to care for the earth.

Hazleton Area Recreation Program

A community garden and outdoor fitness space for children.

Hazleton Integration Project

A community dinner program, serving a diverse population in the Greater Hazleton Area.

King's College

A project to promote environmental education and engagement with the Susquehanna River and Chesapeake Bay through a seven-issue colorzine series, physical activities, and public reading events.

Maternal and Family Health Services, Inc.

Providing free car seats, installation, and education to under-resourced families in Northeastern Pennsylvania.

Northern Columbia Community and Cultural Center

A project to upgrade a fitness facility with the addition of two new commercial-grade treadmills.

Seeds of the Future

A community garden project to foster autonomy and provide agricultural education.

The Berwick Historical Society

Transforming the upper level of the Jackson Mansion Carriage House into an immersive 1860s General Store to educate local grade school students about life in the 1800s.

The Dental Health Clinic

Repairing and upgrading essential dental equipment to support affordable, quality dental care for underserved patients and those living in poverty.

The Wright Center for Community Health

A literacy program at a community health center serving low-income families in Luzerne County.

United Way of Greater Hazleton, Inc

A project to provide oral hygiene supplies to low-income students in 17 Hazleton schools, with a focus on promoting daily oral hygiene habits and improving oral health outcomes.

Volunteers of America of Pennsylvania

Supporting over 120 low-income families by providing maternal services and essential items for healthy infant development.
